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4. JAPANESE CALLIGRAPHY ON A STONE



Grouping:

WORKSHEET 1

Cut a square in the white cardboard (10 cm).

Cut a smaller square in the black card board (6cm).

Glue the black square onto the white square.

Draw Japanese calligraphy by using English names and foreign nouns imported into Japanese through katakana (example : $\forall \land f \lor \nu$ maikeru Michael).

Write a Word in katakana on each side of the white cardboard, with a black marker.

Write your favourite katakana sign on the pebble, using the white Tipex pen.

Glue the pebble in the centre of the black cardboard.

Sign your name in katakana at the bottom of the painting.

Admire your work and show it to the class.
