a.	Fathom	1. The length of a man's foot
b.	Span	2. Old English word <i>fæðm</i> meaning embracing arms or a pair of outstretched arms (used to measure depth of water).
c.	Handbreadth	3. The breadth of a male human hand (used for height of a horse for example)
d.	Foot	4. From the word for a straight branch or rod
e.	Cubit	5. The Egyptian hieroglyph for the unit shows the symbol of a forearm subdivided into 7 'palms' of 4 'digits'
